Collection Arrangements

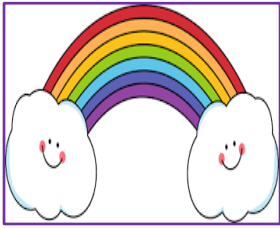

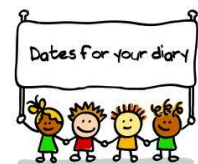
