Staffing Update

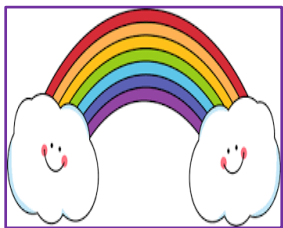

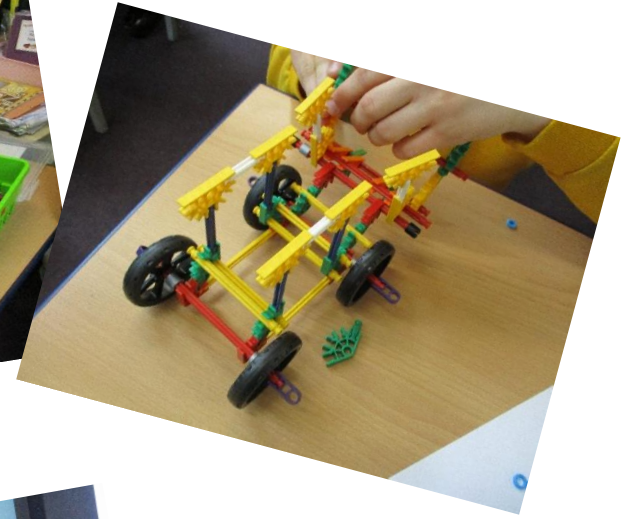
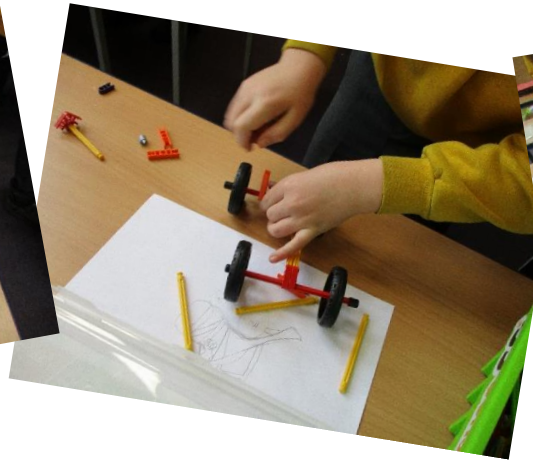
Years 3 and 4 Production
