**Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> December**

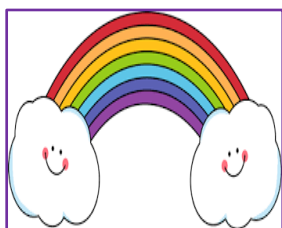
Children may wear a Christmas jumper in place of their school sweatshirt on this day (all other uniform as usual please).
