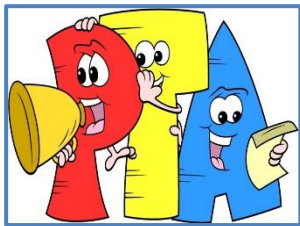


Year 6 – Secondary School Admissions

31st October 2023.

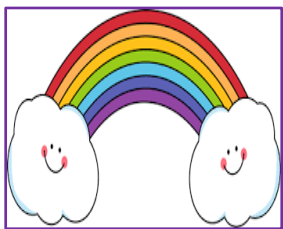


Don't forget that the PTA AGM is next **Wednesday 18th October** at **7.00 p.m.** in the school hall. All parents and carers are welcome to come along.

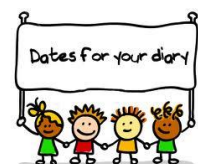

Essex County Council 's policy is that all children born between 1st September 2019 and 31st August 2020 would normally start at primary school in the academic year beginning in September 2024. The Local Authority co-ordinates all admissions to our school. Essex parents must apply for primary school places by completing the Common Application Form, which must be completed **on line** at www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

The closing date for primary applications is **15th January 2024**. This is the statutory national closing date set by the Government.
