




Kensuke's Kingdom and London Eye Mystery are our key texts this term...

....we are learning about **ANCIENT GREEK** life, including their achievements and their influence on the **Western world**.




KEY VOCABULARY

empire—a variety of countries or states ruled by one ruler

democracy—ruled by the people. The first known democracy in the world was in Athens.

In Computing...

....we are learning all about **3-D modelling** and we will explore **selection in programming** to design and code an interactive quiz.



In Science...

....we are learning about the Earth and space, including the movement of different planets. We will also be learning about light and how it travels.

KEY VOCABULARY

Solar system — the sun and all the planets that orbit around it

Rotate —when an object rotates it turns (spins) on its axis

Planet—large round objects, made of rock or gas, that move around the sun

refraction—when light travels from air through water, glass or anything that lets light through, it gets bent

In Geography....


....we will explore the impact of population on different settlements and compare the population and settlements of different cities across the world.

KEY VOCABULARY

settlements—are colonies where people live such as hamlets and cities.

population—the number of people living in a single area.

urbanisation—the growth of towns and cities leading to an increasing proportion of a country's population living there.
