Snack

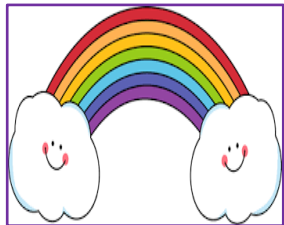
