Young Voices

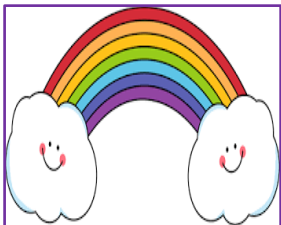
