## P.E. Kit

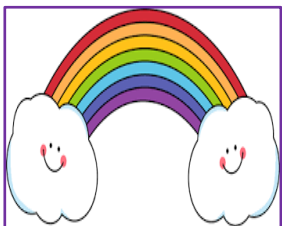


Please remember that children's water bottles must contain still, plain water only. Squash or juice is not permitted in classroom water bottles.
