A message from the School Council

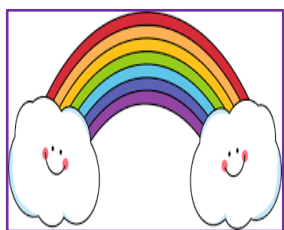

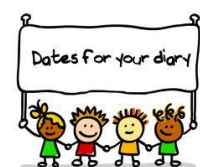
