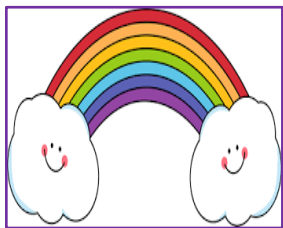
PTA SUMMER FAIR

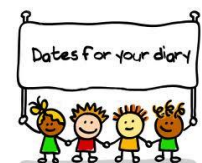
