Star of the Week

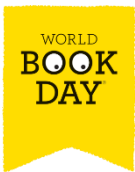
There was no Star of the Week assembly today, as our school photographer was here.

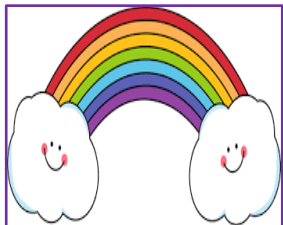
